

### **Greetings from Village Mayor**

Season's Greetings and Merry Christmas to all the good people of the Village of Ryley!



In smaller communities like the Village, Christmas can be a time for the people of the community to come together through Christmas spirit to celebrate a season of giving, gratitude and good will. The Council of the Village of Ryley invites the community to come out on Dec 2 and celebrate together at the Ryley Christmas Festival, starting with the light up of the Village Christmas Tree at 5:30 p.m. followed by a community event at the Ryley Community Center where people can come have a coffee or hot chocolate and visit with friends.

One such method residents can expect soon is a community survey that will be mailed to residents that asks for input on a variety of topics that may have an impact to residents of the Village of Ryley. Return postage will be included for the survey, and I ask everyone to participate.

Lastly, I'd like to ask everyone to take a moment to consider their neighbour. If you're near a fellow citizen who perhaps is having trouble keeping up with shoveling their walkway this winter, consider a few volunteer hours by giving them a hand with their snow. That extra bit of consideration is what makes living in a small community more personable, and some people's lives a little easier.

### TAXervice to manage tax recovery process for Village of Ryley

The Council of the Village of Ryley has voted to outsource tax collection on overdue accounts to TAXervice, a third-party agency which specializes in tax recovery on behalf of municipalities. TAXervice provides location services for property owners who are hard to reach, coordinates with



the municipality on yearly arrears lists, and deals directly with ratepayers, freeing up valuable time in the Village office spent each year attempting to settle overdue accounts. Fees for TAXervice are billed directly to ratepayers in arrears and added to the tax roll, recoverable in the same fashion as taxes. A reminder to all residents, please pay your taxes in a timely fashion – if you wish, a monthly payment installation plan can be set up to make payments easier to manage on a monthly budget. If you are currently in arrears, a payment plan can be set up to a maximum of three years for clearing arrears taxes, as limited in the Municipal Government Act. Taxes are considered in arrears January 1 of the following calendar year from which they were levied. After being in arrears for one full calendar year, the tax recovery process begins, as outlined in the Municipal Government Act.


