- i. Q4 hosting donation ( tonnage fee) - \$92,590.00  
2018 total - \$379, 420.00
- ii. Expansion Application to Alberta Environment and Parks for the North Quarter –  
Clean Harbors met with AB Environment at the end of February
- iii. Cell 4 Construction - this is completed, cell is ready for use.
- iv. New entrance and staging road - not complete due to bad weather last fall. Also, the concrete pad for tipping is not in the budget for 2019. Another layer of rig mats will be added to the current pad.
- v. Lights at new entrance – This would be a decision for Alberta Transportation and Beaver County, as the entrance comes off a secondary highway.
