CAO's Corner:

Hello Ryley,

There is "much ado about BMS and the MCC" these days. What the heck is an MCC anyway? Let us talk about our business of waste management...

A Municipally Controlled Corporation (MCC) is a business for profit that is owned by one or more municipalities (as opposed to a private corporation). Some examples of an MCC are EPCOR in Edmonton and ENMAX in Calgary. The Alberta Municipal Government Act (MGA) legislates everything we do as a municipality and the MGA establishes and controls what an MCC is and how a municipality may operate one. The main purpose of an MCC is to provide one or more municipal service to one or more municipalities as a for-profit business.

A Regional Service Commission (RSC) is often referred to as a "commission" and this is another way that a group of municipalities can cooperate to manage a shared municipal service. Ryley is a member of three commissions and all three of these commissions are partnerships with Tofield, Holden, Viking, and Beaver County. These three commissions are: The Highway 14 Water Services Commission, The Beaver Emergency Services Commission (BESC), and The Beaver Municipal Solutions Service Commission (BMS). Our five (5) municipalities deliver these potable water supply, fire/ emergency protection, and solid waste management services through these three regional services commissions because our councillors sit on the Executive Boards of these RSCs. An RSC is a not-for-profit collaboration.

Beaver Municipal Solutions (BMS) is our regional waste management service and it owns the landfill. BMS has become wildly successful as a business. However, as an RSC the dividend that BMS has provided to Tofield, Ryley, Holden, Viking, and Beaver County over the past few years has been specially approved every year by the Alberta Government. As of 1 September 2020, the Alberta Government will no longer allow this. If we want BMS to continue to run as a for-profit business so it can provide dividends to us, we must transition it from an RSC to an MCC. If we do not, BMS will need to cut their profit-making contracts and Ryley will lose \$200K of annual revenue: revenue that translates to an average of \$388 in annual taxes for a \$100K Ryley home.

That is a simplified version. There are additional factors such as an MCC must pay land taxes while an RSC is exempt. Either way, all five municipal councils have considered all options and factors over the last few years and must all make a choice now because the deadline of 1 September 2020 is upon us. All municipalities held public hearings and Ryley's documentation from that public hearing is still on our website: http://www.ryley.ca/notices/public-hearing-municipallv-controlled-corporation-mcc/

Well, I know that was a tad technical; however, everyone has been asking what it is all about. I hope this helps your understanding.

Recreational Vehicle Reminder

It's that time of year for holidays, camping and trips. Please keep in mind that Bylaw No. 2010-894 13.1 states "No person shall park any trailer, or permit any trailer to be parked upon any highway within the municipality unless the trailer is attached to a vehicle by which it may be propelled or drawn; when the trailer is attached, it shall be deemed to be part of the vehicle to which it is attached, and shall be subject to the regulation pertaining to vehicles unless otherwise authorized by the Administrator."

"Trailer" means a vehicle so designed that it may be attached to or drawn by a motor vehicle and intended to transport property or persons and includes any trailer that is designed, constructed and equipped as a dwelling place, living abode or sleeping place, either permanently or temporarily, but does not include machinery or equipment used in the construction or maintenance of highways.





BUDGET EXPENSES BY STRATEGIC PRIORITIES




