VILLAGE OF RYLEY BY-LAW NO. 2010-892

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF RYLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REQUIRE EVERY NOMINATION TO BE ACCOMPANIED WITH A DEPOSIT FOR ALL CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION TO THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RYLEY

WHEREAS, the Local Authorities Election Act, R.S.A. 2000 Chapter L-21, Section 9 and 30 & amendments thereto, provides that a municipality may impose a requirement for a deposit for every nomination be accompanied with a deposit.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Ryley in the Province of Alberta, ENACTS, as follows:

- 1 This By-Law may be cited at the "Municipal Election Candidates Deposit By-Law".
- 2. Every nomination paper required by the Local Authorities Election Act which nominates a candidate for election as a member of the Council of the Village of Ryley presented to the Returning Officer for the municipal election shall be accompanied by a deposit in the amount or \$100.
- 3. The deposit must be provided in cash, certified cheque or money order payable to the Village of Ryley.
