Advanced Vote: Voting will take place on the **11 day of October, 2017**, between the hours of **10:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. Mountain time.** Voting stations will be located at: **Ryley Municipal Office, 5005-50 St. Ryley, AB**

Election Day: Voting will take place on the **16 day of October, 2017**, between the hours of **10:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. Mountain time.** Voting stations will be located at: **Ryley Municipal Office, 5005-50 St. Ryley, AB**

Eligibility: To be eligible to vote, you must meet the following requirements:

1. You must be at least 18 years old,
2. a Canadian citizen, and
3. a has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and the person's place of residence is located in the area on election day.

If you have any questions regarding your residency, contact the Returning Officer, Michael Simpson, at 780-663-3653.

Voter Identification: When you attend the voting station to vote on Election Day or at the Advance Poll, you must produce valid identification to prove your identity **and** place of residence. The following documents will be considered valid identification:

- a) Photo ID issued by the Federal, Provincial, or local government, that contains your name and current address. Examples of this are a driver's license or other government issued ID. **PO Box numbers will NOT be accepted.**
- B) ID that is accepted by the Province's Chief Electoral Officer. Examples of this are a utility bill, vehicle registration, pension plan or other government benefits statement, bank or credit card statement, or property tax assessment notice. For a complete list of valid ID documents, check the Ryley website at www.ryley.ca, or contact the Returning Officer, Michael Simpson at 780-663-3653.

Only one proof of identity is required, but the identification must show BOTH the name and address of each voter. If your identification shows only your name, you must provide other valid identification that shows your current address.

If you do not produce valid identification, you will not be allowed to vote, even if the election officials at the voting station know you personally.

TAXervice to manage tax recovery process for Village of Ryley

The Council of the Village of Ryley has voted to outsource tax collection on overdue accounts to TAXervice, a third-party agency which specializes in tax recovery on behalf of municipalities. TAXervice provides location services for property owners who are hard to reach, coordinates with the municipality on yearly arrears lists, and deals directly with ratepayers, freeing up valuable time in the Village office spent each year attempting to settle overdue accounts. Fees for TAXervice are billed directly to ratepayers in arrears and added to the tax roll, recoverable in the same fashion as taxes. A reminder to all residents, please pay your taxes in a timely fashion – if you wish, a monthly payment installation plan can be set up to make payments easier to manage on a monthly budget. If you are currently in arrears, a payment plan can be set up to a maximum of three years for clearing arrears taxes, as limited in the Municipal Government Act. Taxes are considered in arrears January 1 of the following calendar year from which they were levied. After being in arrears for one full calendar year, the tax recovery process begins, as outlined in the Municipal Government Act.

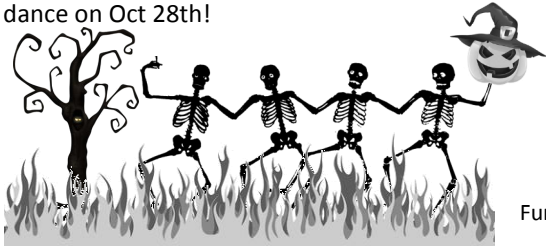

Did you know...

The Ryley Fire Dept consists of 22 members, 3 of which are enrolled in the junior firefighter program with the Ryley School. The program enables the junior member to gain training and experience as well as credits through the work experience program at school. Junior members are followed closely in mentorship with a senior member or an officer, although not allowed to attend actual calls, the members still learn valuable skills and training to graduate into the regular member roll once they turn 18. Ryley Fire attends a variety of calls for brush fires, structure fires, medical assistance, alarms, mvc to name a few. All members receive training in first aid and CPR for health care providers, Alberta Traffic Flagman, and the NFPA 1001 firefighter skills. This past year Ryley Fire has been able to purchase a new scoop stretcher and back board. Through the much appreciated generosity of Beaver Municipal Solutions over the past year, we have received donations to allow us to purchase 2 new complete sets of bunker gear valued at approx. \$2500 per set as well as a full vehicle extrication equipment set. Ryley Fire has been undergoing training to implement the use of these valuable life saving tools in our community. In the 2017 year to date Ryley Fire has attended 48 calls. Ryley Fire is always seeking volunteers that wish to be **dedicated** members in their community. Ryley Fire will be hosting their annual Halloween Dance (age 18+) on October 28th from 8pm-2am at the Ryley Community Centre. This is your chance to show your support for your firefighters as well as dress your best and have a great time. Tickets are \$10 at the door and we have some great prizes throughout the evening. The funds raised work towards our continued efforts for an ATV brush unit. In the Ryley area there is many remote areas that our trucks just cant get to. An ATV unit gets us in there not only for fire suppression but use for search and rescue as well. 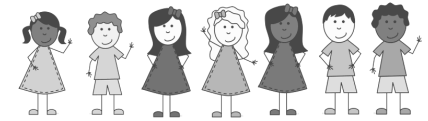

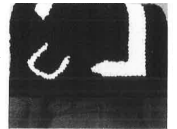
