Information Items. Clean Harbors Expansion Plans

Mike Parker: An environmental assessment was not required for the newly acquired land

The company is proposing that new cells be from 5 to 7 meters under ground level.

Currently, the lay –down area can't have waste on it

It will take at least 2 years for approval of the entire proposal

Berms on the underground cells may be only 3 meters high

The entrance off of Hwy 854 must be moved directly across from the BMS entrance.

Classification of waste must be by chemical analysis, as the Alberta Environment mandate is getting more strict.
