**May 6th, 2020—Ryley Community Hall**

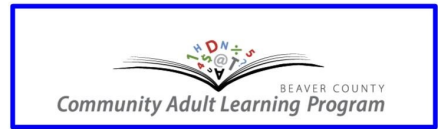
A community presentation will take place in the evening where you will learn the types of human trafficking, common myths vs. realities and the work that ACT Alberta does in our province.
