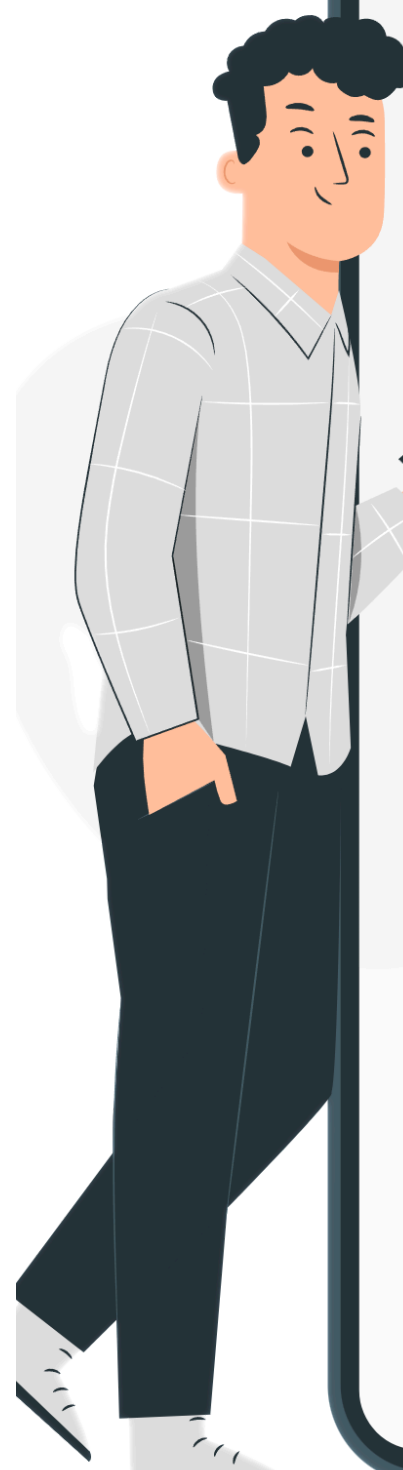

Hello Ryley!

I'm sorry for not writing over the past few months. I will put more effort in communicating in the future and will do my best to write for each publication.

We held a little social event in our new Community Resource Centre on Tuesday 30 April. I was happy to see some old familiar faces and hear some opinions and viewpoints. I wish more of you had come out so we could hear from you too. Either way, all our councillors and all our staff enjoyed chatting with those of you that came out and we heard some great ideas.

In case you haven't heard, we are taking over the Ryley Waterpipes. Highway 14 Water Commission will still pump water down the highway from Strathcona County into our Ryley Water Reservoir. We will manage the underground waterpipes in the Village and deliver water services to your home. We haven't quite settled on a date for official handover, but I am working on August 1st – Yes, that is correct: this summer!

So, what does this mean to you? Well, we are reviewing our total sewer and water utility billing system, and we will set up something new with sewer and water combined. Highway 14 Water Commission will no longer be your water service provider – the Village will become your “one-stop-shop” for water and sewer services. It's early days and much needs to be coordinated, but it will happen this summer. Stay tuned for more information.

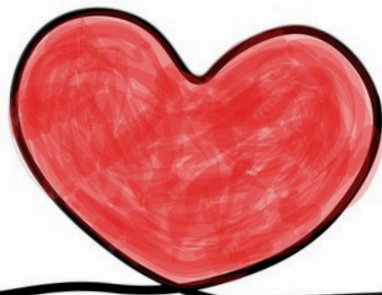
