CAO CORNER

Hello Ryley! I hope your Summer is off to a great start.

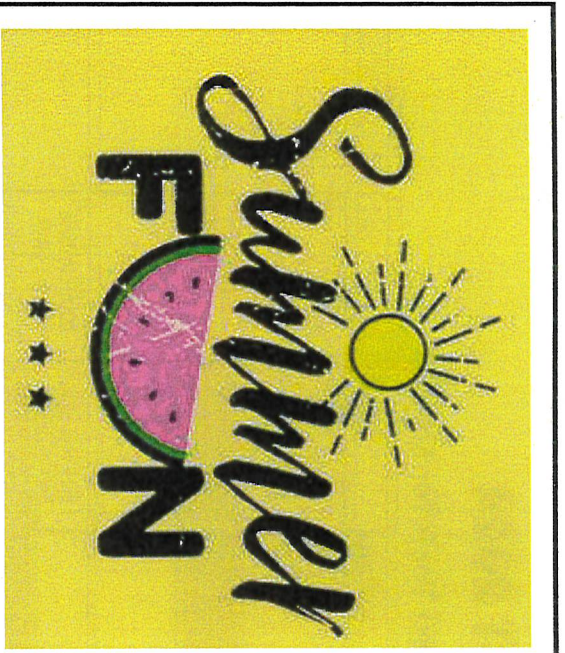
Council approved our 2024 Ryley Taxation Bylaw last month, and we have now mailed out your Tax Assessments. Council, my team, and I have worked very hard to avoid an increase like we the Village was forced to impose on you last year. I feel that we have been very successful, and I am proud of this year's results.

Although we are suffering a 10% increase to our total average requisitions and cost sharing fees that we must pay out, such as Provincial Policing, Provincial School Fund, Regional Seniors Foundation, and Regional Emergency Services, we were still able to reduce operational costs and get our 2024 over 2023 Municipal Tax Levy increase under 3%. This is extraordinary, when considering that the Alberta Inflation rate (Consumer Price Index - CPI) exceeds 3% for every month so far in 2024. It reached 4.2% in February and 3.5% in March but we still squeezed in a 2.93% Tax Raise!

The great news is that Ryley is growing. It's not by very much, but it is getting economically stronger. Our total land assessment value: in other words, your average property value, rose by 2.83% since last year. This may not seem like much, but this small growth brings 15 thousand dollars more in taxes at our current tax rate. Or, put in a different and happier way for our community, as our total Village land assessment value goes up, Council could tax a lower mill rate to collect the same amount of tax dollars.

Unfortunately, we are still depleted of our reserves and surpluses and these need to be rebuilt in the next few years so we can do things, like fix roads. The 2022 extreme deficit budget and the related over-expenditures are still going to take many years to correct and recover from. Stabilizing 2023 and 2024, Council has established balanced budgets and has curbed spending and that has made a huge difference. We now need get into a surplus budget situation where we will be putting money back into our capital and infrastructure reserve accounts. That's a story for next year's budget.

Until then, take care and "Live the Life of Ryley".

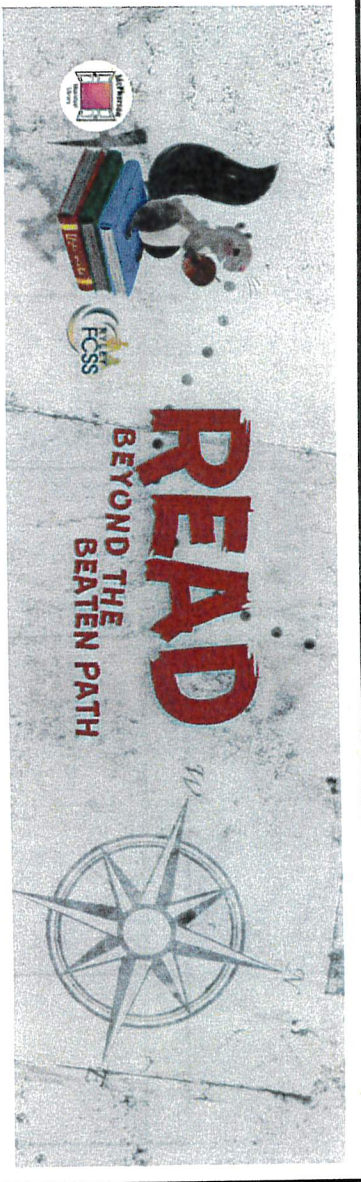
