



VILLAGE OF RYLEY BYLAW NO. 2020-937 To Amend Tax Penalty Bylaw 2017-926

A Bylaw of the Village of Ryley in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to establish temporary amend Bylaw 2017-926 which sets the taxation due date provides for the imposition of a penalty on all current taxes remaining unpaid on certain specified dates in the year of the levy.

WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to amend the taxation due dates and penalty dates for the year 2020 only, due to the global pandemic

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Village of Ryley, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 2017-926 is amended by temporarily deleting the following wording of Section 1:

1. That if after seventy (70) days from the date of mailing tax notices, in any year any current taxes remaining unpaid shall be added thereto by way of a penalty in the amount of ten (10) per cent per annum.


With the effect of removing the first tax penalty of ten (10) per cent.

This temporary amendment shall expire on December 31st, 2020.


READ a first time this 19 day of May, 2020.
