

BYLAW NO. 2026-1009

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF RYLEY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE TAX PENALTY BYLAW NO. 2017-926

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M26, hereinafter called the "Act", as amended, Section 191(1) states that the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal the bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Ryley wishes to amend its Tax Penalty Bylaw 2017-926 for the purpose of extending the tax penalty date by 14 days for current taxes for the year 2026 only;

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Ryley, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

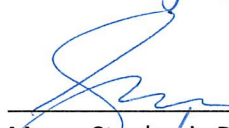
- a) For the 2026 year only, that if after eighty-four (84) days from the date of mailing tax notices, any current taxes remaining unpaid shall be added thereto by way of a penalty in the amount of ten (10) percent per annum.

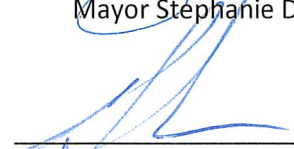
This Bylaw comes into full force and takes effect on the date of third and final reading.
